Further to our email below, please find both specific and more general feedback about your CDT from the mid-term review process:

The CDT has a range of excellent features such as recruitment of students from a range of scientific backgrounds, good international links and a high number of industrial partners. The allocation of a role for every student creates a strong association of students with the centre and provides ownership of its success.

It is evident how the CDT has evolved from the first centre to the renewal bid and how the plans have been implemented. The strong links with the industrial partners have enhanced the student experience and have contributed to a well-rounded training programme for students that includes academic, administrative and peer support. Making the training courses available to a wider audience through the National Associates schemes is a notable broadening of the student cohort to other (industrially-) funded students in the thematic areas.

The RO is fully invested in the success of the CDT and is providing further resources to support its running.

EPSRC believes by further building and leveraging industrial partner support, the CDT is on track to perform at a high level.

Note to all CDTs: EPSRC thanks CDTs for their hard work in compiling their Equality and Diversity (E&D) data and comparing this with wider data available. However, the Oversight Panel observed the lack of analysis beyond the raw data represented a missed opportunity, whilst relatively few CDTs discussed developing an Action Plan on E&D issues.
